ARTICLES OF FAITH

Art. 1. We believe in one true and living God - Father and Son and Holy Ghost equal in essence, power and glory. **(Scripture - For there are three that bear record in Heaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost and these three are one. 1 John 5:7)**

Art. 2. We Believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God, and that the Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments are the inspired Word of God, and our only rule of Faith and Practice. We recommend and endorse the use of the King James Version of the Bible in our Churches. **(Scripture - Who is he that overcometh the world, but he that believeth that Jesus is the Son of God? 1 John 5:5)**

Art. 3. We believe that by the offence of one judgement came upon all men to condemnation, even so by the righteousness of one the free gift came upon all men unto justification of life, by which the grace of God became equally accessible to all men. **(Scripture - Therefore, as by the offense of one judgement came upon all men to condemnation; even so by the righteousness of one the free Gift came upon all men unto the justification of life. Romans 5:18)**

Art. 4. We believe that sinners are justified by the grace of God, received through faith in the Lord Jesus Christ. **(Scripture - For by Grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves; it is the Gift of God: Not of works lest any man should boast. Ephesians 2:8-9. Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ. By whom also we have access by faith into this grace wherein we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God. Romans 5:1-2)**

Art. 5. We believe in the resurrection of the dead, both of the just and the unjust, and that the happiness of the righteous, and the punishment of the wicked will be eternal. **(Scripture - Marvel not at this; for the hour is coming, in the which all that are in the graves shall hear his voice, and shall come forth; they that have done good, unto the resurrection of life; and they that have done evil, unto the resurrection of damnation. John 5:28-29)**

Art. 6. We believe that the Church of God is composed of those who have been partakers of the Holy Ghost, and tasted of the good Word of God, and the powers of the world to come. **(Scripture - Then Jesus said unto them, Verily I say unto you, Except ye eat the flesh of the Son of Man, and drink His blood, ye have no life in you. Whoso eateth my flesh, and drinketh my blood, hath eternal life; and I will raise him up at the last day. John 6:53-54)**

Art. 7. We believe that we have an Advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous, and that He is the propitiation for our sins, and not for ours only, but for the sins of the whole world. **(Scripture - My little children, these things write I unto you, that ye sin not. And if any man sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous, and He is the propitiation for our sins: and not for ours only, but also for the sins of the whole world. 1 John 2:1-2)**

Art. 8. We believe that only those who have received remission of sins are fit subjects for Baptism, and that immersion in water is the only mode. **(Scripture - And he commanded the chariot to stand still; and they went down both into the water, both Phillip and the eunuch; and he baptized him. Acts 8:38)**

Art. 9. We believe that the Lord's supper and the washing of the Saint's feet are ordinances of the Lord and shall be observed by the Church until the Second Coming of Christ. **(Scripture - If I then, your Lord and Master, have washed your feet; ye also ought to wash one another's feet. For I have given you an example that ye should do as I have done to you. John 13:14-15)**

Art. 10. We believe that the Gospel is the power of God unto Salvation to everyone that believes, and that it is commanded to be preached to every creature; and that all men are responsible for the manner in which they hear. **(Scripture - Take heed therefore how ye hear; for whosoever hath, to him shall be given; and whosoever hath not, from him shall be taken even that which he seemeth to have. Romans 2:13. For not the hearers of the law are just before God, but the doers of the law shall be justified. Luke 8:18)**

Art. 11. We believe there is but one true Church, and that every member thereof is an heir of God and joint heir with Christ; and not one member of His Church shall ever perish. **(Scripture - And if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ; if so be that we suffer with him, that we may be also glorified together. For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord. Romans 8:17; 38-39. And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand. My Father, which gave them me, is greater than all; and no man is able to pluck them out of my Father's hand. John 10:28-29. But he that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved. Matthew 24:13).**

CONSTITUTION

We, the various undersigned Regular Baptist Churches of Jesus Christ, desiring to perpetuate unity and maintain correspondence with each other, by the grace of God, do assemble ourselves together trusting alone in God, whose grace is sufficient. Oh, that He may work in us both to will and to do that our light may shine before men to the glory of God; that we may be as wise as serpents and as harmless as doves. We agree to keep the rules of an association according to the following form of government: viz.

Art. 1. This body shall be known as Enterprise Association of Regular Baptists. It shall be composed of one lay delegate from each church only, belonging to that body, and each church shall be entitled to one vote.

Art. 2. Each Church shall have one vote in this Association, same to be by delegate appointed or selected by such church or his alternate appointed or selected by Church and in the absence of both delegate and his alternate, the moderator of such church shall have the right to vote for such Church.

Art. 3. The object of this association shall be to promote among Churches thereof sympathy, fraternal union, and mutual cooperation.

Art. 4. This association shall have no power over the Churches other than the right to inquire into their condition to advise them, and to withdraw her fellowship from each as may be corrupt in doctrine or practice.

Art. 5. This Association shall meet annually at such time and place as shall be determined by the Association.

Art. 6. The Moderator and Assistant Moderator, the Clerk and Assistant Clerk shall be chosen by the suffrage of the delegates present; and they shall be eligible to succeed themselves.

Art. 7. It shall be the duty of the permanent Moderator to proceed immediately to appoint such committees as may be necessary to conduct the business of the Association.

Art. 8. Any Regular Baptist Church may be admitted to membership in this association by a two-thirds vote of the membership present.

Art. 9. There shall be a permanent record book kept, wherein a record of the proceedings of every session of the Association shall be recorded by the Clerk and the records be available at every business session of the Association.

Art. 10. Any motion for amendment to the constitution or articles of faith shall be reduced to writing and filed with the Clerk and shall not be voted on or passed at the same session, but must lie over until the next session for final consideration and vote. Said motion shall be printed in the minutes of the Association.

FOR GOVERNMENT OF CHURCHES

1. That each Church, as a collective body, use their utmost endeavors to protect their Church against the winds of doctrine that gender discord, thus destroying the peace and progress of our beloved Association.
2. That local Churches, before inviting strangers to preach, should require evidence as to their qualifications and Doctrine either in writing or verbal reports.
3. No Church of this Association shall Preach, License or set aside for Ordination to the Ministry of the Gospel or Deacon of the Church any brother who is married to a divorcee, or who has divorced his wife and has married another woman. No minister from this Association shall serve in a presbytery to ordain such in another organization. A divorced minister shall not serve as Pastor or Assistant Pastor. I Tim. 3:1-7 and 3:8-13.
4. A man must preach six months before being licensed, then being found sound in Doctrine and Practice by not less than twelve months trial, before being ordained,.
5. No church of this Association shall set apart nor ordain a woman as a Minister, nor shall any Minister of the Association serve in a Presbytery to ordain such.
6. All Ministers of this Association shall be granted Credentials from their home Church, recommending them both for Doctrine and Practices, and signed by the Church Moderator and Clerk. Credentials shall be renewed each year, by voice vote of the Church.
7. (A) Ministers leaving another Association and taking membership in a Church of the Enterprise Association must be licensed twelve months under the watch care of that Church. During the twelve months, the Minister must bring Credentials and come before the Board of Directors for review. (B) When a Minister, carrying Credentials issued by a Church of the Association, leaves the Association, his

Credentials are voided and the Church is duty-bound to reclaim these Credentials and deliver them to the Association. (C) Before any Minister may reclaim his Credentials from his home Church or the Association, he must come before the Board of Directors.

8. All Churches of this Association shall call their Moderators and Assistant Moderators from the Ministers of the Enterprise Association.
9. No Minister may vote in any Church except the Church of which he is a member but as Moderator in a Sister Church he may cast a vote to break a tie vote.
10. No Church may receive into Fellowship of their Church body any person who, for disorderly conduct has been dismissed from a Sister Church of this Association or any other Association until they have made peace and satisfaction in their home Church. Any member transferring between Sister Churches must have a letter of fellowship. (This does not apply to members of Churches of other Associations who have been excluded from their Churches for Communing with Churches of the Enterprise Association.)
11. New Churches desiring membership in the Enterprise Association shall send a delegate and letter to the Association and be recommended by two other Churches in good standing in our Association.
12. No delegate may withdraw his Church letter from the Association after it has been accepted by the body, nor withdraw the Church from the Association except first consulting the Church.
13. A delegate shall not object to a Church nor another delegate on hearsay information; all charges shall be first hand knowledge obtained from your own investigation.
14. The Delegate or his alternate shall be present at all Business Sessions of the Association in order that his Church has representation. If the delegate leaves without being excused, their Church may be rebuked or other action may be taken against the Church by the Association.
15. Should this Association elect to receive any Church or Association of Churches into the membership of this Association, all of the members of the Church or Churches shall immediately be members of this Association. The Ministers of any Church received by this Association before being duly qualified Ministers in this Association shall go before the Board of Directors of this Association on Friday of the Annual Meeting of the Association and, if found qualified, shall be installed as Ordained Ministers with all privileges accorded to the Ministers of this Association.
16. We the Enterprise Association of Regular Baptist Churches believe God has ordained marriage and defined it as the covenant relationship between one biological man (Genesis 2:7) and biological woman (Genesis 2:22). Therefore, the Enterprise Association of Regular Baptist Churches will only recognize marriages between one biological man and one biological woman as taught in the Scriptures (Genesis 2:23-24). Furthermore, the ministers of the Enterprise

Association of Regular Baptist Churches shall only participate in weddings and solemnize marriages between one biological man and one biological woman and the churches, facilities and the property of the Enterprise Association of Regular Baptist Churches shall only host weddings between one biological man and one biological woman. And that no church of the Enterprise Association of Regular Baptist Churches may receive into fellowship of their church body any person who is a known homosexual, lesbian, or transgender person (Romans 1:26-27). Furthermore, the restrooms or bathrooms of the Enterprise Association of Regular Baptist Churches shall only be used accordingly to one's biological birth, biological man (men) to use restrooms designated men or male and biological woman (women) to use restrooms designated women or female. And that the Enterprise Association bases its teachings and guidelines for living, marriage and sexuality according to the Word of God, which is the final authority on the way people ought to live their lives.

17. We the Enterprise Association stand against abortion except for the sake of saving the life of the mother.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THE ENTERPRISE ASSOCIATION OF REGULAR BAPTIST CHURCHES OF JESUS CHRIST

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, George Travis, Willard Conley and Charlie P. Barrett, desire to form a corporation without capitol stock from which no private pecuniary profit is to be derived, for the purpose of conducting the business hereinafter set forth, do hereby associate ourselves to become a body corporate in accordance with the Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I. The name of the corporation shall be the Enterprise Association of Regular Baptist Churches of Jesus Christ.

ARTICLE II. Said corporation shall be located at Catlettsburg, Boyd County, Kentucky, and it's principal business there transacted.

ARTICLE III. George Travis, whose address is 1606 Center Street, Catlettsburg, Kentucky, is designated as process agent for the service.

ARTICLE IV. The nature of the business objectives and purposes proposed to be transacted, promoted and carried on, is to improve the spiritual, moral, and social condition of the inhabitants of the City of Catlettsburg and vicinity thereabout; to have the management of the property belonging to said Enterprise Association of Regular Baptist Churches of Jesus Christ, to own the property, both real and personal belonging to said Church; to enter into contracts on behalf of said Church; this corporation shall have the power to build, own and lease any real estate necessary to carry the purpose of this organization and may sell any real estate, mortgage the same, and may do all things necessary to the management of the property of this organization.

ARTICLE V. This corporation shall have no capitol stock.

ARTICLE VI. This corporation shall commence it's existence when these articles of incorporation have been acknowledged, filed, and recorded as required by law and shall continue for Ninety-nine (99) years.

ARTICLE VII. The affairs of this corporation shall be conducted by a Board of Directors consisting of three (3) members chosen from the members of the Enterprise Association of Regular Baptist Churches of Jesus Christ, immediately after these articles of incorporation have been recorded as required by law, and shall hold the office according to the bylaws of said corporation or until their successors are elected and qualified. The election of directors may be had after the first directors are chosen on the first meeting. Anyone who is in good standing and more than twenty-one (21) years of age, may be chosen by the other members of said Association to act as a director of this corporation. Meetings of the members of said Association to elect Directors shall be called and advertised by the rules and regulations of said Association now in force. Vacancies in the Board of Directors may be filled by the remaining members of the Board. Said Board of directors shall be entrusted with the management of the affairs of this corporation, the raising and disbursing of the funds and care of it's property. Said Board of Directors shall elect one of the members who shall act as President of the Corporation and it shall be his duty to preside at all meetings of the Board and shall have all power that is usually exercised by the President of a Corporation. A secretary of the Board may be elected by the members of the Board and his duty shall be to keep the minutes of all meetings of said Board of Directors and perform all duties generally performed by a secretary of a corporation; said secretary is not required to be a member of the Board of Directors, but must be a member of the Association. The secretary will also be the treasurer of the corporation and his duty as treasurer will be the same usually performed by the treasurer of a corporation. The president of said corporation when authorized to do so by a majority of the Board of Directors, may execute deed notes and sign checks and execute contracts on behalf of the said corporation of every kind which it is authorized to make.

ARTICLE VIII. The private property of the incorporation or persons who may become members of this corporation shall not be subject to and is exempt from the payment of corporate debts.

OF REGULAR BAPTIST
CHURCHES OF JESUS CHRIST**

ORGANIZED OCTOBER 26, 1894
INCORPORATED AUGUST 20, 1955

BY-LAWS

-1-

The name of this Corporation shall be Enterprise Association of Regular Baptist Churches of Jesus Christ, organized October 26, 1894 at Enterprise, Johnson County, Kentucky, and chartered August 20, 1955 at Catlettsburg, Kentucky.

-2-

The governing body of this Corporation shall be composed of members of the Delegation of the Association appointed by the Moderator and approved by the Delegation.

-3-

There shall be three members from the Kentucky Churches, three from Ohio Churches and three from Indiana Churches. The Association Moderator and Clerk are members by virtue of their offices.

-4-

After Adoption of this Charter, board members shall be elected for terms of three years, two years and one year, and thereafter one new Board member each year. The Board members shall elect their President and Secretary.

-5-

There shall not be two members from the same Church serving on the Board at the same time.

-6-

Church membership in this Association shall be by petition. It shall be the duty of the Board of Directors to consider all applications for membership in this Association, and to notify all applicants of their acceptance or rejection.

-7-

To be eligible for membership in this Association, the Church applying for membership must be a Regular Organized Baptist Church believing and assenting our Articles of Faith, Constitution, Doctrine and Practices, and the Rules for the Government of Churches.

-8-

The Board of Directors shall have the authority for issuing the Charters of Churches or withdrawing them for violations, on approval of the Delegation.

-9-

If a member Church shall be guilty of violating the rules of the Association, the constitution, Articles of Faith, or practice Doctrines or Beliefs contrary to the Constitution or rules for the Government of Churches, it's Charter shall be withdrawn.

-10-

The Association Membership Certificate issued to each Church shall be displayed in the Church as long as the Church remains a member of the Association.

-11-

If any Church desires to leave the Association in full fellowship, it may do so by surrendering their Charter to the Association.

-12-

This Board will have no power nor authority over Church property except that said Church property is deeded to the Association or at the request of the church to dispose of their property, then authorization must be at the direction of the Association, while it is in session. (Reference is to Article 4, of Corporation.)

-13-

That each Minister of this Association shall have their Credentials stamped with the Charter Seal.

-14-

Charter Board of Directors meetings will be each second Saturday of the following months: November, May, and Thursday before Association.

Note: By-law number 5 shall be construed by the membership to mean that two members from the same Church shall not serve as elected Board members at the same time. This rule does not apply to the Moderator and Clerk who serve on the Board only by virtue of their offices.

Minutes of the One Hundred Twenty Eighth Annual Session Of The Enterprise Association Of Regular Baptist Churches

Friday Morning, August 6, 2021

The Enterprise Association met in the Enterprise Baptist Youth Camp Tabernacle for service. Moderator Roger Dean Ball welcomed the congregation to the One Hundred Twenty Eighth Annual Association and Brother Randy Wagoner opened the service in prayer.
